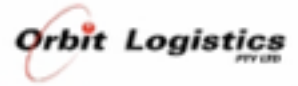

## MATCH REPORTS

### SENIORS

After starting pre-season training back in mid November, practice matches in March, and seventeen rounds of the season, we now came to round eighteen and the last games of the season away to Pascoe Vale.

For U18 and Reserve grades, these games would determine who would finish fifth on their ladders as both had equal points with Pacco. The seniors were playing for a strong finish to the year as Pacco have already qualified for finals and can't move from third or fourth.

The U18s game saw our boys get off to a good but inaccurate start kicking 2 goals 6 behinds for the quarter to lead narrowly at quarter time. Unfortunately they let Pacco off the hook in second and they scored five goals to lead by 29 points at half time. With some pride on the line the guys fought their way back into the game during the third quarter to trail by 20 points at three quarter time. An extra effort was asked for to finish the season strongly and the boys delivered drawing level half way through the quarter. For some reason the pressure was released and Pacco went on to score the final two goals of the game and ran out 13 point winners. This meant our boys finished with 8 wins for the season and in sixth place, the best result for our U18s for many years. Well done on a great year.

Reserve grade was a close game until after half time when the Marby boys put on five goals to three to lead by 16 points. The last quarter was again Marby's as they put on another four goals to two to run out winners by 27 points. As with the U18s this was the best season by our Reserve grade for a number of years with nine wins for the season and finishing in fifth place. More to look forward to next year as the number of young players in this group can only be improved by their efforts this year.

Onto the senior game. Pacco had given our boys a solid defeat earlier in the year, but the boys were confident they could go close in the return match today. At quarter time it was game on as scores were level. The second quarter ran the same as the U18 game with Pacco putting on 6 goals to our 2 and run into half time with a 28 point lead. Determined not to let this get away the guys put on four goals to one in the third quarter to trail by only a goal at three quarter time. A tight last quarter was on the cards but a chance to level the scores early was missed and Pacco put on a couple of quick goals and looked to have the game in control. Marby had different ideas though and continued to fight the game right out eventually losing by 9 points, with the last quarter highlight a goal (first for the season) to Joe Martiniello from the half back line really getting the Marby crowd excited. Again a much improved year to book 7 wins and much to look forward to. Seniors played 43 players during the season giving some of the younger guys more valuable experience which can only be beneficial going forward.

Well done to all the teams, including the U18 Div 2 boys who battled with numbers all season. Thanks to everyone who helped out during the year, without the support of these great volunteers the players would simply not get out on the park each week. All get a well earned rest for a few months before we start training again in November, bring on 2016.
